Chatham County's Elected Boards to Meet, Honor Rep. Hackney and Sen. Atwater

PITTSBORO – On Thursday, June 21, the Chatham Economic Development Corporation (EDC) will host a joint meeting with the Board of Commissioners, the town boards of Goldston, Pittsboro, and Siler City, and the Board of Education to recognize state Representative Joe Hackney and state Senator Bob Atwater. Both will retire when their current terms end.

The event is scheduled for 7:00 – 8:30 p.m. at the Siler City County Club located at 150 Country Club Drive in Siler City.

The EDC will honor Representative Hackney and Senator Atwater for their service and leadership representing Chatham County and surrounding areas at the state level.

Senator Atwater assumed his position representing District 18 – comprised of Chatham, Durham, and Lee counties – in 2005.

Chatham County native Representative Hackney represents District 54, with constituents in Chatham, Orange, and Moore counties. In his 16 term career in the legislature, Hackney has held several leadership positions including speaker of the house and speaker pro tempore.
